Program:	RAZ-Kids.com
Description:	Hundreds of books engage students with animation and sound effects as they listen to fluent reading, record their own reading for practice, and take comprehension quizzes on what they read. Teachers can assess particular reading skills with online assessments. Students earn stars for reading and quiz activity to spend equipping their own Raz Rocket. They also have access to collections of poetry books, song books, and nursery rhymes.
Targeted Students:	RAZ-Kids.com is a subscription based online program purchased for Title 1 student use.
Format:	This program is used as an independent small group activity and can also be used at home for students to read leveled text.
Assessment/ Progress Monitoring:	Fluency can be monitored having the student read selected passages into a headset. Comprehension is monitored on a separate teacher page. It includes how many attempts the student made to pass the quiz, a fraction of questions answered correctly over a total number of questions, and also breaks down errors into specific skills.
